The competitive advantage of the department is the educational laboratory, the material and technical base of which allow to optimize training in the disciplines of the professional cycle, such as in the Information and Analytical Technologies of State and Municipal Management programme, State and Municipal Finance programme and so on.

Students take internships at state and local self-government authorities, with which they subsequently connect their professional activity.

Career guidance meetings are held annually not only with local self-government authorities, but also with representatives of legislative and executive authorities of regional and federal levels.
