**Programme description**: The Master's degree 40.04.01 Jurisprudence programme was developed based on the Federal State Education Standard of Higher Education 3++ while also accounting for the needs of the regional labour market and the traditions and achievements of the Institute of Law and taking into account the requirements of federal legislation.

The Master's programme combines fundamental academic training in the theory of administrative law and administrative procedure with a number of practically-oriented courses.

- understand the prospects for the development of the science of administrative law and procedure in Russia and abroad;
- gain research and practical skills, the ability to search for nonstandard solutions to improve the substantive and procedural legislation and practice of its application;
- continue studies and personal development in science in postgraduate studies in a related programme.
